

1. Pray for Mrs. Hidalgo's upcoming appointments: October 24th with Dr. Manucha for her pre-op before her Cataract Surgeries scheduled for December 9th and 30th of this year. Pray for her CT scan this Friday, October 18th with Dr. Stouffer at 10:45, which is a six week follow up on her swollen Aorta in her lung. If the Aorta has remained the same, then the above appointments for her Cataract Surgeries will be done. The Lord God, whom we love, trust, and serve will show forth His healing power. Pray that the message of Salvation that was shared will take root and there will be souls saved in Jesus' precious name.
2. Please continue to remember in prayer all who live in the state of Florida, as Hurricane Milton brought great destruction. Thank the Lord that we were able to keep in contact with Rev. Jack A. She also was the one who was in a very bad accident a few months ago that we prayed for. She is doing well and has recovered. I mention this next story because with tears in my eyes, I found out this past Wednesday that she has cancer in her lymph node and is going through chemotherapy treatments and then major surgery. She is a young lady that loves the Lord (born again) and has two young children. She said it was okay for me to share this with you. She is trusting in the Lord whom she loves, and thankful for your prayers.
4. Pray for James Pelkey's mother, who spiritually continues to refuse to accept the 'Gospel Message of Salvation,' which makes it very difficult for the Pelkeys and their family. James's wife Shelly is asking us to pray that Holy Spirit would protect her, (her health) until they have insurance for her in December. Please keep this whole family in your prayers.
5. Pray for Heather, who has been a help to Mrs. Hidalgo with her insurance needs, she has been displaced because of the recent storm. Pray for their family that God will give them peace and provide for their needs.
6. Pray for Sabrina Clemmon's daughter Dana, who will be having her appendix removed on November 4th. Please also pray for her daughter Tracy's baby girl Elena who recently had

hernia surgery and will be having heart surgery on November 6th. Pray for the Lord, our divine Healer, to direct the surgeons' hands and to comfort them in this time.

7. Continue to pray for Mrs. Hidalgo's great-granddaughter Sadie that the iron drops for her anemia would help to resolve her iron deficit. Thank you so much for your prayers!
8. Pray for Pastor Suresh, his family, and his congregation as they deal with various health issues, persecution, weather disasters and other ministry obstacles in India.
